PUBLIC COMMENTS:

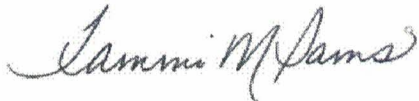
Kathy Prescott - raised question why would you start a new employee at \$16.00
